Alterations and additions to a Californian Bungalow on Bronte Park. The clients' brief included an extra bedroom, a study, a bigger/open living area, a feeling of beach house, catching some sunshine due to the garden's orientation on the southern side, and a carport. The proposal was to keep the existing house at the front and extend at ground level towards the park with a light timber structure with timber or plywood cladding. All the bedrooms, bathroom and laundry are located in the existing structure. The extension is an "L" shape generating an entry courtyard protected from the ocean wind. The skillion roof opens to the north to catch light and sunshine.
